Remote ID has no chance of doing what it intends to do, anyone flying where they aren't supposed to or flying illegally will not have remote ID or will have modifications to hide GPS location, and anyone doing it legally will be following the rules already.

While we are at it we should re evaluate the FPV drone laws. Most FPV pilots don't fly where they're drone can't be recovered, and we don't fly in places where we know we shouldn't, so why do we need 2 separate pilot licences (costing around \$6000), HAM radio licence, a spotter, and CASA approval to go fly a toy around an empty park?
