Fundamentals for future Drone Management

1. Self-assessment and regulation does not work.

Licences should only be issued once full and strict requirements are met.

2. Drones should not go over houses that identify themselves as a 'No Drone Zone' or similar.

Drones fly too low for them to just be able to move between locations. People in their homes MUST have the right to not permit drones to fly over the homes, which would otherwise be an intrusion, invasion of privacy, and also noise.

3. Homes/community have the right to take down nuisance drones

Guidelines and legally permissible routes to eliminate/take down nuisance drones MUST be included in any rules, regulations for introducing drones.

4. Community Charter and Voice

The community must be represented in a Charter that must be met by drone operators, with non-compliance resulting in removal of licence to operate.

5. Audits

Audits of drone operators including community feedback to determine if licences will be extended/re-issued, with a maximum of 3 years with removal of licences for non-conformers.
