Submission 9 – Confidential

This is a private and confidential submission. Drones specifically fly in an angle so that the government drone flightpath views into my loungeroom at night 2 or 3 times a night on most nights. There is only a small view area width of one and a half feet by 3 feet in which to view in where I am sitting and the drone always flies within that space. The lights are bright and then the drone circles around and flies back. The drone is not low enough to target views into lower-level units. My unit is on level 5. I am on disability payments, but have never broken the law, no drugs, am a general non-drinker of alcohol and have no convictions - summary or indictable, not even a ticket offense. I am a 60-year-old woman who feels this is extremely invasive of my privacy. It is offensive to think that authorities perhaps feel because I am on disability that they have a right to continuously invade my privacy or that I need constant surveillance. There is no justification for this invasion of privacy in my home and I believe this WA state or local Perth government policy should be reviewed. I have kept visual evidence of this constant surveillance on my privacy. Confidential.
